## Sydney Airport Traffic Performance September 2020

Total passenger traffic in September 2020 was 132,000 passengers, down 96.4% on the prior corresponding period (pcp).

34,000 international passengers passed through Sydney Airport in September, down 97.5% on the pcp. Domestic passengers totalled 98,000 for the month, down 95.7% on the pcp.

Throughout October 2020 travel restrictions affecting some of Sydney Airport's domestic markets were lifted. Travel restrictions between New South Wales and South Australia and New South Wales and the Northern Territory were lifted on 1 October and on 9 October respectively.

Internationally, one-way quarantine-free travel from New Zealand to New South Wales, the Australian Capital Territory and the Northern Territory commenced on 16 October 2020.

The downturn in passenger traffic is expected to persist until further government travel restrictions are eased.
