

RESEARCH PROGRAM WITH UNIVERSITY OF MIAMI HEALTH SYSTEM TO ADVANCE BREAKTHROUGH LUNG TECHNOLOGY

- 4DMedical and University of Miami Health System will establish the Functional Lung Imaging Research Program to advance breakthrough lung technologies
- This is 4DMedical's first research program in the U.S. and will use the Company's proprietary XV Technology[™] to improve assessment and outcomes for patients with chronic lung diseases
- The research program will comprise of preclinical and clinical studies and allow physicians to have a targeted approach to the therapeutic options available to patients, driven by information available using XV Technology[™]
- It is expected that this research program will be another driver of acceptance and adoption of XV Technology[™] at hospitals and clinics located in the U.S.

The Functional Lung Imaging Research Program, 4DMedical's first research program in the U.S. health system, will use the Company's proprietary XV Technology[™] to improve treatment outcomes for patients with chronic lung diseases. More specifically it will allow researchers and physicians to accurately diagnose ventilatory abnormalities in patients, therefore providing treatment and management options that are targeted and more effective.

This research program is expected to deliver a number of preclinical and clinical studies that will include patients with various lung-related conditions, such as emphysema, cystic fibrosis, pulmonary hypertension, pulmonary embolism and lung cancer.

The research program will fall within the Division of Pulmonary, Critical Care and Sleep Medicine.

Utilising the Company's XV Technology[™] platform, XV LVAS converts sequences of X-ray images into four-dimensional quantitative data, allowing physicians to better diagnose and treat patients with respiratory diseases.

Supported by more than 15 years of development in Australia, 4DMedical's XV Technology[™] improves the capacity of physicians to diagnose and treat patients with respiratory diseases more efficiently, by providing objective measurements of regional lung motion and air flow.
