ACCC Update - Federal Court Penalty

Kogan.com Limited (the Company; Kogan.com; ASX: KGN) advises that the Federal Court today imposed a penalty of \$0.35 million on Kogan Australia Pty Ltd in respect of the four day coupon code promotion conducted in June 2018, which was found by the Court to have contravened the *Australian Consumer Law* as disclosed to the ASX on 17 July 2020.

As previously announced, the profit derived by the Company from the promotion was immaterial, and the prior ruling will not have any impact on the Company's ongoing promotional activities, which were updated in 2018. Kogan.com has a compliance program in place, which comprises protocols for the internal and external review of promotional statements and associated collateral.

The Company made a provision of \$0.7 million for the potential penalty and costs in its FY20 accounts.

In it's Judgement today, the Federal Court noted that, "... Kogan did not deliberately intend to engage in the contravening conduct and the material does not indicate a culture of non-compliance or disregard of the law."

The Company is currently reviewing the ruling of the Federal Court and may provide a further update once its review is complete.
