IBX Secures Additional Capital - Shareholders Exercise Options

MELBOURNE — Imagion Biosystems Limited (ASX: IBX) (the **Company** or **Imagion**) announces that it has received a total of \$267,030 for the exercise of options.

Comprised of \$80,460 for 1,609,200 Listed Options exercisable at 5 cents, expiring on 26 November 2021 and \$186,570 for the exercise of 6,219,000 Listed Options exercisable at 3 cents, expiring on 28 April 2023.

The exercise of these options has resulted in the issue of 7,828,200 fully paid ordinary shares, as outlined in the attached application for quotation (Appendix 2A).
