Voluntary Suspension Request

We refer to the trading halt granted to Atrum Coal Limited (Company) on 9 February 2021.

Pursuant to ASX Listing Rule 17.2, the Company requests the voluntary suspension of its securities from the commencement of trading on Thursday 11 February 2021.

The Company provides the following information regarding this request:

- 1. The Company requests a voluntary suspension as it is not yet in a position to make an announcement regarding the reinstatement of the Alberta Government's 1976 coal policy and the implications of this policy change on the Company.
