NEARMAP MADE AWARE OF COMPLAINT IN UNITED STATES DISTRICT COURT (UTAH)

Nearmap Ltd (NEA:ASX) advises that, following the ASX announcement (“Nearmap Increases FY21 ACV Guidance”) made on 4 May 2021, Nearmap was made aware on the morning of 5 May 2021 of a complaint filed against its subsidiary, Nearmap US, Inc. in the United States District Court (District of Utah, Northern Division).

The complaint alleges patent infringement relating to the plaintiffs’ roof-estimation technology. The allegations do not affect Nearmap’s core proprietary technology and do not affect the surveying of imagery or the delivery of premium content. The business remains unaffected.

The complaint has been filed on behalf of Eagle View Technologies, Inc. and Pictometry International Corp. The plaintiffs are seeking unspecified monetary damages and the prevention of alleged further infringement in relation to the plaintiffs’ roof-estimation technology.

Commenting on the matter, Chief Executive Officer and Managing Director, Dr Rob Newman, said “Nearmap has always taken the subject of intellectual property rights and patent protections seriously and believes the allegations are without merit. We will vigorously defend against the complaint. The business remains unaffected by the complaint.”
