



SOR Japanese Nanocube Memory Technology Patent Granted

December 7th 2021 - Strategic Elements Ltd (ASX:SOR) is pleased to announce that a patent filed over the Nanocube Memory Ink technology has been granted in Japan. This Japanese patent, JP6968057, is a Japanese jurisdictional equivalent to AAM's US patent granted in January 2020. The patent family is held by 100% owned subsidiary Australian Advanced Materials Pty Ltd.

The Company is developing printable computer memory and printable battery technologies with a team of world leading development partners. As announced (22/09/21), unrestricted access and full-time operations re-commenced at the University of New South Wales. This has enabled an increase in resources available to the development team for Q4 Battery milestones and for certain work related to the Nanocube Memory Ink to commence in Q1 2022. The Company is exceptionally pleased with progress in the Battery Ink technology.
