Johns Lyng Group have been appointed by the Victorian Government's Emergency Recovery Victoria (ERV) to assist those affected by the ongoing flood disaster.

At this point it is estimated that 34,000 homes will be inundated or isolated in the coming days and weeks and there are at least 24 local government authorities impacted at this stage.

Nick Carnell, CEO of Johns Lyng Group Australia, says as Australia's largest integrated disaster recovery and building services provider, the Group is well positioned to lead and coordinate this vital work.

"Johns Lyng is prepared and ready to assist Victorians at this difficult time and will work tirelessly with ERV to alleviate the challenges that our fellow Victorians are facing," Mr Carnell said.

"This emergency is unfolding, and it is important that resources are mobilised rapidly and effectively. We have the experience and knowledge to fully mobilise for a catastrophe of this scale, most recently through our ongoing work in the Northern Rivers of NSW and Southeast Queensland and the June 2021 Victorian storms."

A spokesman for the Victorian Government said: "It is important that we move as quickly as possible. Johns Lyng have been a panel member providing services to ERV for several years and we are pleased to partner with them on this significant project."

Mr Carnell added: "It is too early to estimate the scope of work and our initial priority will be ensuring that Victorians affected by this flooding event are safe and secure, so our state can begin the journey to recovery."
