

FY23 FINANCIAL RESULTS UPDATE - INVENTORY IMPAIRMENT

As part of Australian Dairy Nutritionals Limited's (**AHF** or the **Group**) audit of its financial results for the year ended 30 June 2023, AHF advises there will be a \$917k inventory impairment.

Previously the Group advised the market it expected a \$150k-250k impairment in respect of inventory of the future Gradulac Gentle range however, as part of the audit process the Board has concluded additional impairment is necessary as domestic sales of the range have not reached expectations.

The Group will lodge its Appendix 4E and Annual Report on Thursday 31 August 2023. Subject to final sign off by the auditor and the Board, there will be a net loss from continuing operations of \$6.9m, a net loss from discontinued operations of \$2.3m, net fair value gains of \$1.0m and a total comprehensive loss of \$8.2m. Obviously, this is a very disappointing result and further commentary will be provided to the market on release of the Appendix 4E and Annual Report.

The release of this announcement was authorised by the Board of AHF.
