Results of 29 August 2023 Extraordinary General Meeting and Proxy Summary

At the Extraordinary General Meeting of Pointsbet Holdings Limited (**Company**) on 29 August 2023, the following business in the Notice of Meeting was carried by the requisite majority:

Resolution 1 – Return of Capital

Approval was given for a return of capital, in aggregate across two tranches, not exceeding A\$458 million.

The resolution was decided by poll.

Resolution 2 – Approval of Benefits to Specific Employees

Approval was given for the Company and its subsidiaries to give benefits to certain named KMPs in connection with the transfer of the whole or part of the undertaking or property of the Company, in the form of early vesting of performance share rights on a pro-rata basis.

The resolution was decided by poll.
