COMMENCEMENT OF MOSAIC CUSTOMER BETA PROGRAM

HIGHLIGHTS

- Commencement of MOSAIC Customer BETA Program
- Successful completion of sending and receiving Export Customs Messages to the Australian Customs Test Systems (ICS)
- Finalised integration of TCMS with Direct Couriers Australia

Yojee Limited (**ASX: YOJ, “Yojee” or “the Company”**) is pleased to announce that it has commenced its MOSAIC BETA program with a small group of Australian and New Zealand freight forwarders and customs brokers. The BETA program is planned to run in Q4 CY25.

The objective of the BETA program is to perform live use case testing on the MOSAIC platform with a variety of customers in order to improve and ensure rapid and robust commercial delivery. The program will require customers to create Export Airfreight Jobs directly from the MOSAIC platform. This includes Job Creation, EDN (Export Declaration) and AWB (Airway Bill) messaging, document creation and issuing an invoice.

We have identified a small number of forwarders to work with us in a staged approach. This includes data gathering, data population, training and job processing. We will use the results of this program to gain valuable customer feedback and insights to further iterate and develop our Imports and Sea modules. Early-stage customer feedback is vital for the rapid and successful adoption of the MOSAIC platform, allowing us to scale transactions quickly.

As part of the BETA program, operators will be sending and receiving live messages to and from Australian and New Zealand Customs.

This milestone represents a significant step on our path to a MOSAIC commercial release in H2 FY26.

Yojee has completed a major integration project connecting our TCMS module with Direct Couriers Australia's own in-house TMS (Transport Management System). We anticipate that this integration will potentially unlock significant transactional volume with our TCMS customers in Australia.
