## **ASX ANNOUNCEMENT**

### **Mattel Inc v MGA Entertainment Inc Bratz Products**

Funtastic distributes Bratz products in Australia and New Zealand and also holds licenses in relation to Bratz products.

On 29 April 2009 Funtastic learned of further developments in the USA litigation between Mattel Inc and MGA Entertainment Inc concerning the intellectual property rights in Bratz products.

On 27 April 2009, the US Judge appointed a Temporary Receiver to MGA entities including MGA Entertainment Inc. The Temporary Receiver has taken control over and will manage those entities pending a further hearing on 18 May 2009. The Judge confirmed that retailers and distributors can still purchase and sell Bratz products up to and including 31 December 2009.

On 18 May 2009 the Judge will consider whether the appointment of the Temporary Receiver should be made permanent.

This ruling does not affect Funtastic's ability to supply Bratz products at least until 31 December 2009. Funtastic is making inquiries of MGA and expects to receive further information from MGA and the Receiver in the coming weeks. Further information concerning arrangements after 31 December 2009 is unlikely to be available until after the further hearing on 18 May 2009.

The Chief Executive Officer of MGA, Isaac Larian, has said that MGA will appeal the decision.
